

EMDRC Property COVID - 19 Safe Plan – (Revised 22 April 2022)

As the peak of the Omicron wave begins to subside – and with almost 70 per cent of adults now armed with their third dose – the Victorian Government has advised that most restrictions will be removed effective from 11:59 pm, Friday 22 April.

The following items have been **removed and no longer required**:-

1. Density limits removed.
2. The QR code sign-in process will no longer be a requirement, for the sport and recreation sector EMDRC members and visitors no longer need to sign in using the Service Victoria app.
3. A nominated COVID Safe Marshal is no longer required for all gatherings at the Clubrooms.
4. All Members and Visitors in attendance are no longer required to be fully vaccinated. In other words, Patrons won't be required to have two doses or show their vaccination status before entering the venue.
5. Masks are no longer required for most indoor and outdoor settings. Specifically, those cooking and or preparing food will no longer be required to wear a mask, this is also applicable for members utilizing the club BBQ subject to the usual cleaning requirements.

The following items **remain in place** and form the EMDRC Clubrooms COVID safe plan.

1. **Suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19** - Advise the Club Property Manager 0412 941695 who will alert Council and the Department of Health.
2. Following State Government recommendations, the club will also do its best to consider keeping the clubrooms well ventilated, by opening windows and doors where possible. This will encourage airflow from outside helping reduce the risk and spread of COVID-19.
